

County Councillors Report November 2019

Community of Henllanfallteg

I have written to HDUHB to suggest they use the Ash tree chippings to run a biomass boiler and support the new hospital energy systems. The suggestion came from a Community Councillor at Henllanfallteg and was shared back to them. CCC were also asked.

Social Care and Health

CCC have received about 12 million from HDUHB towards the transition. I may have mentioned this before but the money is now there to support the transition. Some of this will be used to support Apps for those based at home in order to keep them connected to their communities with people who have similar interests.

Policy and Resources Committee

Predicted CCC overspend of around 3 million that needs to be addressed in the round of budget meetings although the WAG settlement figure is not yet known until the 16th December. Concerns expressed by Cllrs about the situation of the Carmarthen Mart although this does benefit Whitland Mart in the interim. When resolved we may see less footfall from the local Mart but will have to consider other options in this area. There is potential locally but something to be mindful of.

Car Parking Issues

Removal of the extra unwanted disabled bay at King Edward street and placement of one requested is under consultation. The markings were confusing and people were being fined.

The 1974 leases on the private land near the train station have expired. This could create a shortfall of parking within the Town. TBC

General Issues

Leaves in the Town Hall Car Park swept, Two lamppost lights replaced, Drains cleared at Cwmfelin Boeth, Planning policy guidance given to two parties, Meeting with NR and CCC concerning the old sidings. Estyn Inspections undertaken at both Whitland schools in the third week of November and attended Llys Hywel pre inspection Governors meeting. Trevaughan area stream and drains cleared and some support beams to be placed. Resident Parking Scheme chased up by Vicky so forwarded the information to her. Fencing and possible leaking radiator problem, requested resolution. Tree planting concern from resident. Pavement by the Dentist is sinking so have requested it be rectified. Attended Memorial Service at St Marys Church, Taste of Christmas , Whitland lights switch on and Henllanfallteg Christmas Fair dressed as a reindeer.
