Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting of Whitland Town Council held remotely, via the medium of Zoom, on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2021, at 7.00pm.

**2021/05 EM 28 Apologies for Absence** - Cllrs Ffion Scourfield, Rhys Davies, John Dobson Frank Connor-Hughes, and Natasha West

**2021/05 EM 29 To consider prices presented to the Council and approve the purchase of a storage container**

Following voluminous enquiries regarding the cost to supply a storage container and the state of repair of second hand units. Cllr Shipton presented the cost, to Council, of a new unit supplied and fitted from a firm based in Carmarthen - £3,650 Plus VAT.

Following discussion and consideration of the Finance Regulations, Cllr Shipton proposed that Whitland Town Council accept the price of £3,650 to supply and fit a new storage container to be located at Parc Dr Owen, for the storage of Council property; Cllr Mc Dowell seconded the proposal with all Cllrs in full agreement.

This unit will be funded by money allocated to the speed sign in Trevaughan Road, now to be funded by Carmarthenshire County Council and the VAT rebate from 2020/2021 (received June 2021 from HMRC)

**2021/05 EM 30 To consider the prices received and then to approve such to ensure the continued insurance of Whitland Town Council**

Following perusal of the prices provided and consideration as to whether Whitland Town Council should enter into a three year contract, notwithstanding the fact that next year the premium will alter due to the installation of the new play park, Cllr Shipton proposed that Whitland Town Council accept the price from BHIB of £836.67 and enter into a one year contract; Cllr Davies-Scourfield seconded the proposal with all Cllrs in full agreement.
