1. NOMINATION PAPERS

Nomination Papers may be downloaded via: www.electoralcommission.org.uk; alternatively you can contact the Elections Office on 01267 228889, ElectoralServices@carmarthenshire.gov.uk or obtain from the offices of the Returning Officer, Block 4, Parc Myrddin, Richmond Terrace, Carmarthen, SA31 1HQ, Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays), who will at the request of any elector prepare a nomination paper for signature.

2. DELIVERY OF NOMINATION PAPERS

It is advisable that Nomination Papers are **hand delivered** to the Returning Officer in the Council Chamber, County Hall, Carmarthen SA31 1JP between 10am and 4pm on any working day from the date of publication of this notice (excluding bank holidays) but no later than **4pm on Tuesday, 5 April 2022**. Alternatively, candidates may submit their nomination papers at the following locations on specified dates between the hours of 10am and 4pm.

Llanelli Town Hall, Town Hall Square, Llanelli, SA15 3AH – Wednesday 23 March

Ammanford Town Hall, 5 Heol Iscennen, Ammanford, SA18 3BD – Tuesday 29 March

Nominations may be submitted electronically by scanning the nomination papers and emailing to: Nominations22@carmarthenshire.gov.uk. However, to ensure that it is received safely and securely we recommend submission by hand.

It is the responsibility of candidates to ensure that the Returning Officer receives nomination forms in the correct way by the required deadlines.

An electronic read receipt from the Returning Officer is not confirmation that the nomination is valid. The Returning Officer will send a notice to inform candidates of their decision as to whether or not their nomination is valid.

3. POLL

If the election is contested, then a poll will take place on **THURSDAY, 5 MAY 2022**.

4. ABSENT VOTES

Electors and their proxies should take note that applications to vote by post must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Block 4, Parc Myrddin, Richmond Terrace, Carmarthen by **5pm on TUESDAY, 19 APRIL 2022**, if they are to be effective for this election. This includes alterations to existing arrangements for postal voting by electors or their proxies who already have an indefinite or fixed period postal vote.

Applications to appoint a proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by no later than **5pm on TUESDAY, 26 APRIL 2022** except in cases of where unforeseen illness, or incapacity occurs after that time in which case applications may be made up until **5pm on THURSDAY, 5 MAY 2022**.

All applications and notices regarding absent voting must be sent to the Electoral Registration Officer, Block 4 Parc Myrddin, Richmond Terrace, Carmarthen SA31 1HQ.
